

The ARTS at Marks Garage: Call to Artists

Now Here from Nowhere: The Future History of Navigation

Dates: January 11 to February 26, 2011.

Theme: Create innovative maps, way-finding, and artful directions for the course of your vehicle, your community, or your life. Share your interpretations, strategies, depictions and instructions with a past that has yet to occur.

Deadline: Please submit images of appropriate works dealing with the theme of *Now Here from Nowhere*, entry form, and appropriate payment, to The ARTS at Marks Garage by **December 20** at 6pm.

Image Requirements: Jpegs or slides are accepted; no original works please. Jpegs must be no larger than 1MB. Each image should be titled with your NAME & TITLE of the artwork being submitted (e.g. John Baldessari-PURE BEAUTY.jpg). Email submissions to info@artsatmarks.com, drop off, or mail to The ARTS at Marks Garage (see address in Fees section). Optional submission: an explanation of your work for our jurying; how it relates; concept, context, etc...200 words maximum.

Fees: \$10 per entry. Up to three pieces per artist. You may submit up to 3 images per piece. Payment **MUST** be received in order to be a part of the jury process. Cash or check only. Please make checks out to The ARTS at Marks Garage. Drop-off or mail payment to The ARTS at Marks Garage, 1159 Nuuanu Avenue, Honolulu, HI, 96817.

Jurying: Jpegs of appropriate works will be juried by the Partner organizations of The ARTS at Marks Garage.

Notification: Accepted artists will be notified **December 22** by telephone or e-mail.

Eligibility: Open to all artists and all media. No size limitations. Work must be suitably prepared for installation.

Delivery: Actual works due at Marks between Tuesday **January 4** to Friday **January 7** from 11am–6pm. No late works will be accepted. Shipping or delivery of works, both ways, is the responsibility of the artist.

Installation: Sunday, January 9 and Monday, January 10, from 10am to 6pm. Artists are required to help install their work.

Reception and Events: Artist reception on Slow Art Friday, **January 21**, 6 to 9pm. First Friday Honolulu, **February 4**, 5 to 10pm. Expected attendance: over 2,500.

Pick-up: Artwork must be picked up between 10 and noon, Sunday, **February 27**. Sold work should be picked up Tuesday **March 1** to Friday **March 4**.

Conditions: The ARTS at Marks Garage will charge a 40% commission on sales. Artists are required to help with the installation of the show, and sit a shift at the gallery. All selected entries must remain for the duration of the show.

Non-Liability: The ARTS at Marks Garage or the Hawai'i Arts Alliance shall not be liable for loss or damage to any works of art entered. Participation indicates that the entrant understands and accepts this clause and conditions stated.
