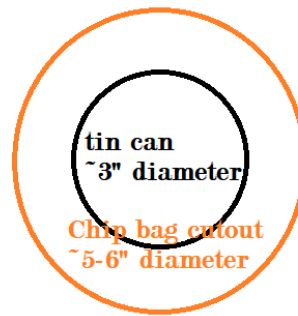


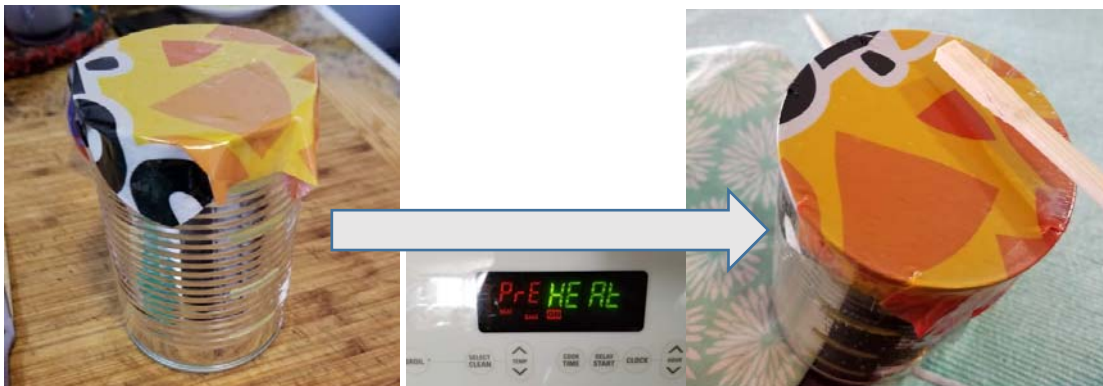
## STATION 1: Tin Can Drums

### MATERIALS:

- Tin can (any size) [cut out top and bottom for double-headed drum]
- Tostitos or similar chip bag
- Scotch tape and/or rubber bands
- Chopsticks (or similar) as drumsticks



1. Cut out chip bag into circle with diameter at least 4 inches longer than can's diameter.



2. Pull bag tight and tape down *thoroughly*....set oven to 350 degrees (Fahrenheit). Cook for ~45 seconds (the plastic will shrink and stretch to frame)



3. CAREFULLY (with tongs) remove from heat. ***DO NOT TOUCH the membrane*** until the metal has cooled completely (it will disturb the tautness of the skin and wrinkle it). For extra fun, try cutting off top and bottom for a double-headed drum (significantly more resonant tone).

4. Use chopsticks to play. Enjoy 😊
